 - Pass the state exam (\$115-\$135)

- At least 1 year of accounting experience
- Pass the <u>CPA Exam</u> (Approx. \$900 with \$170 application fee)
- No residency or citizenship <u>requirement</u>

Registered Nurse Job Description:

• Assess patient health problems and needs, develop and administer nursing care

Entry Level Requirements:

- Complete an accredited nursing program in New York
- Pass the National Council Licensure Examination-Registered Nurse (NCLEX-RN) exam (\$200)

Nurse Practitioner Job Description:

• <u>Diagnose</u> and treat patients independently or as part of a healthcare team

Career Advancement Requirements:

- Earn a graduate degree in a nursing specialty
- Become <u>nationally certified</u> by an accredited agency; renewal every 3 years
- Apply for license

Immigration in New York

The following are facts about the <u>immigrant community in New York</u>:

- Immigrants comprise 23% of the state population and 28% of the New York labor force
- Top industries of immigrant employment:
 - Health Care and Social Assistance, 604,741 workers
 - Accommodation and Food Services, 301,593 workers
 - o Retail Trade, 284,432 workers
 - o Education Services Trade, 232,726 workers
 - Transportation and Warehousing, 224,796 workers
- 348,547 immigrant business owners account for 34% of all self-employed New York residents

- 58% of immigrants in New York are naturalized and another 15% are undocumented
- Top foreign-born countries of origin:
 - o Dominican Republic, 11%
 - o China, 9%
 - o Mexico, 5%
 - o Jamaica, 5%
 - o India, 4%
- 18% of native-born New Yorkers are children of an immigrant
- Educational attainment of foreign born adults in New York:
 - High School diploma or less 49%
 - \circ $\,$ More than HS diploma, less than Bachelor's degree 18%
 - Bachelor's degree or higher 33%
 - Share of <u>Brain Waste</u>* 21%
