Food Preparation Worker Job Description:

• Perform a variety of food preparation duties other than cooking

Entry Level Requirements:

• Food Handler Certification- not required by North Carolina State law, but recommended

• Food Handler Certification offered <u>online</u> (\$10, 30 min, available languages: English, Español, 普通话, 한국어, Việt, American Sign Language, Tagalog, Serbo-Croatian)

Certified Food Manager Manager Job Description:

• Responsible for food safety to protect the public from foodborne illness

Career Advancement Requirements:

- Pass the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) certification exam (\$55)
- Online courses are not required, but provide knowledge for the ANSI exam

- Accounting training programs in North Carolina are listed <u>here</u>

Accountants & Auditors Job Description:

- <u>Analyze</u> financial information and prepare financial reports on activities in an organization Career Advancement Requirements:
 - A Bachelor's degree with Accounting concentration

- 1 year of <u>experience</u> in accounting **OR** 4 years in academia, a self-employed setting or in the general field of accounting
- Pass the <u>CPA</u> exam (Approx. \$900 with \$230 application fee)
- Pass an <u>Ethics</u> course within 1 year of applying for CPA license (\$245-\$295, 8 hours)
- Social security number, residency and citizenship are required

Registered Nurse Job Description:

• Assess patient health problems and needs, develop and administer nursing care

Entry Level Requirements:

- <u>Complete</u> an accredited nursing program in North Carolina
- Pass the National Council Licensure Examination-Registered Nurse (NCLEX-RN) exam (\$200)

Nurse Practitioner Job Description:

• Diagnose and treat patients independently or as part of a healthcare team

Career Advancement Requirements:

- Earn a graduate degree in nursing speciality
- Become <u>nationally certified</u> by an accredited agency
- Apply for license

Immigration in North Carolina

The following are facts about the immigrant community in North Carolina:

- Immigrants comprise 8% of the state population and 11% of the North Carolina labor force
- Top industries of immigrant employment:
 - Manufacturing, 87,871 workers
 - o Construction, 80,211 workers
 - Accomodation and Food Services, 62,978 workers

- Health Care and Social Assistance, 54,703 workers
- Retail Trade, 49,968 workers
- 61,838 immigrant business owners account for 12% of all self-employed North Carolina residents
- 39% of immigrants in North Carolina are naturalized and another 39% are undocumented
- Top foreign-born countries of origin:
 - o Mexico, 28%
 - o India, 9%
 - o Honduras, 4%
 - o China, 3%
 - o El Salvador, 3%
- 7% of native-born North Carolinians are children of an immigrant
- Educational attainment of foreign born adults in North Carolina:
 - High School diploma or less 50%
 - More than HS diploma, less than Bachelor's degree 17%
 - o Bachelor's degree or higher 34%
 - Share of <u>Brain Waste</u>* 20%

^{*} Share of <u>immigrant professionals</u>, who are unemployed, employed at poverty-level wages in High School diploma or less jobs, or significantly underemployed in more than HS diploma, less than Bachelor's degree jobs
