Immigration in Texas

The following are facts about the immigrant community in Texas:

- Immigrants comprise 17% of the state population and 22% of the Texas labor force
- Top industries of immigrant employment:

- o Construction, 517,957 workers
- Manufacturing, 361,818 workers
- o Health Care and Social Assistance, 353,961 workers
- Accomodation and Food Services, 336,864 workers
- o Retail Trade, 332,182 workers
- 429,414 immigrant business owners account for 29% of all self-employed Texas residents
- 38% of immigrants in Texas are naturalized and another 33% are undocumented
- Top foreign-born countries of origin:
 - o Mexico, 51%
 - o India, 6%
 - o El Salvador, 5%
 - o Vietnam, 4%
 - o Honduras, 3%
- 16% of native-born Texans are children of an immigrant
- Educational attainment of foreign born adults in Texas:
 - High School diploma or less 57%
 - More than HS diploma, less than Bachelor's degree 16%
 - Bachelor's degree or higher 26%
 - Share of <u>Brain Waste</u>* 21%
