The following are facts about the <u>immigrant community in Wisconsin</u>:

- Immigrants comprise 5% of the state population and 6% of the Wisconsin labor force
- Top industries of immigrant employment:
 - Manufacturing, 56,934 workers
 - Health Care and Social Assistance, 23,387 workers
 - Educational Services, 21,171 workers
 - Accommodation and Food Services, 20,674 workers
 - o Retail Trade, 16,352 workers

- 15,458 immigrant business owners account for 6% of all self-employed Wisconsin residents
- 48% of immigrants in Wisconsin are naturalized and another 24% are undocumented
- Top foreign-born countries of origin:
 - o Mexico, 28%
 - o India, 8%
 - o China, 5%
 - o Laos, 4%
 - The Philippines, 3%
- 5% of native-born Wisconsonites are children of an immigrant
- Educational attainment of foreign born adults in Wisconsin:
 - High School diploma or less − 51%
 - More than HS diploma, less than Bachelor's degree 18%
 - Bachelor's degree or higher 32%
 - Share of <u>Brain Waste</u>* 21%
