 growing need for testers who can administer this oral assessment remotely for our English at Work
 courses located across the country.
- Testers join online classrooms for 1.5-hour sessions to pre- and post-test participants individually, in breakout rooms, according to BEST Plus 2.0 guidelines for remote administration.
- There is no set commitment for this position and the opportunities are advertised on a monthly basis. You may sign up as you are available. Sessions are held on various time zones, throughout the day.
- The English at Work team provides an orientation to navigating our LMS & online classroom, detailed instructions on our assessment process and all testing materials.

Qualifications:

- Best Plus 2.0 Administrator Certification and an understanding of oral language proficiency in the context of an assessment
- Experience working with first-time online learners with low digital literacy skills
- Interest in working with language learners at various levels of proficiency
- Experience with teaching ESL and administering other standard ESL assessments that report on the NRS scale is a plus
