ABOUT THE NATIONAL IMMIGRATION FORUM AND AMERICA IS BETTER

Founded in 1982, the **National Immigration Forum** (the “Forum”) advocates for the value of immigrants and immigration to the nation. In service of this mission, the Forum promotes responsible federal immigration policies that satisfy today’s economic and national security needs, and honor our Founding Fathers’ vision of America as a land of opportunity.

In 2011, the Forum embarked on a new strategy to engage conservative faith, law enforcement and business leaders at local and national levels. We believe that in order to effectively facilitate immigration reform, we must build support for citizenship and immigration among center-right constituencies.
