Negative Impact on EMPLOYERS



U.S. employers would lose nearly **\$1 billion** in turnover costs.

Negative Impact on INDUSTRIES

Industries that employ most TPS holders and face large worker shortages

-- like construction, restaurants and food services, child day care, and grocery stores --

would suffer the most.

Negative Impact on EMPLOYEES



About **27,000** TPS holders are business owners, creating jobs for themselves and other U.S. workers.

OVERALL NEGATIVE ECONOMIC IMPACT

The U.S. GDP would lose **\$45-\$164 billion** over the next decade.
