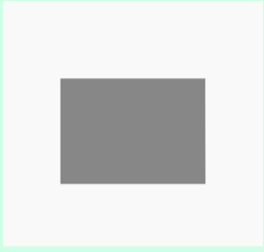




## Colorado needs Dreamers and TPS recipients to stay
