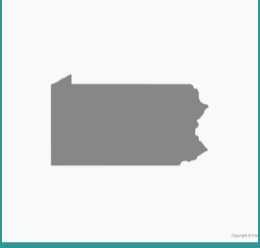




Pennsylvania needs Dreamers and TPS recipients to stay
