Who files taxes using an ITIN?



Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITINs) are tax processing numbers that are only available to noncitizens who...

- *don't have a Social Security Number (and aren't eligible to get one) and*
- *are either required to furnish a federal identification number or to file a federal tax return.*

File taxes under an ITIN each year

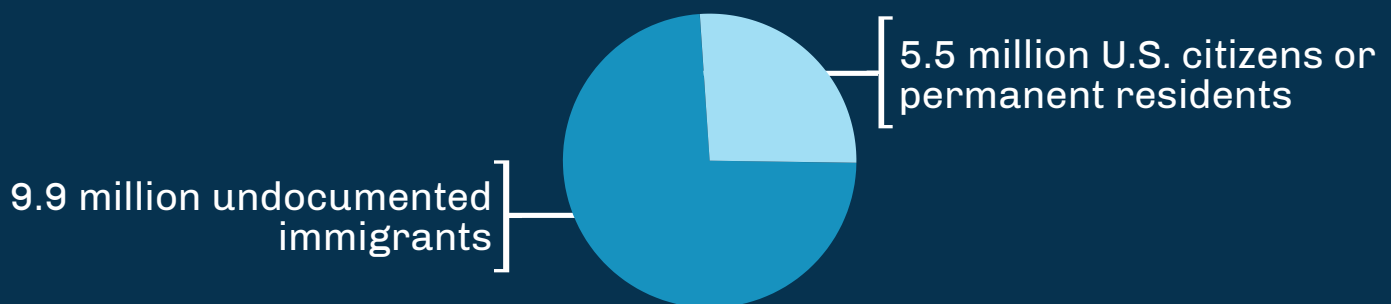
\$5.5 billion
