

# Upcoming Fee Changes Impact Workers & Their Families

USCIS fee changes will go into effect on [October 2, 2020.](#)



The new USCIS fee rule will impact workers who need to maintain status or access benefits for themselves and their families.



## Obtaining or Renewing Work Authorization

Application for Employment Authorization (I-765)

**New Fee:** \$550  
**Old Fee:** \$410

**↑ \$140**

Asylum seekers will be required to pay the fee for the first time.

DACA recipients are exempted from the fee increases.



## More Fee Changes

### Changing or Renewing Nonimmigrant Status (I-539)

**New Fee (Paper Filing):** \$400  
**New Fee (Online Filing):** \$390  
**Old Fee:** \$370

**↑ \$20-30**

### Sponsoring a relative for a green card (I-130)

**New Fee (Paper Filing):** \$560  
**New Fee (Online Filing):** \$550  
**Old Fee:** \$535

**↑ \$15-25**

### Green Card Renewal (Form I-90)

**New Fee (Paper Filing):** \$415  
**New Fee (Online Filing):** \$405  
**Old Fee:** \$455

**↓ \$40-50**
